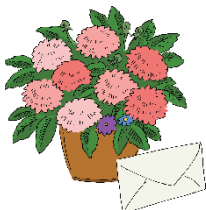

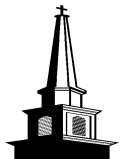
October 26 – A discussion of the morning’s sermon, led by Rev. Snyder.
