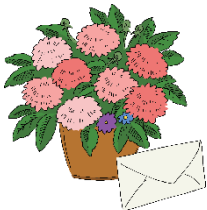

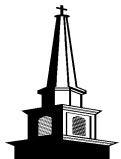
BOOKWORMS
