Christians and Jews Together

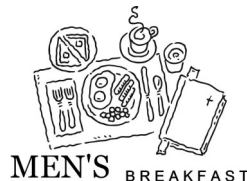

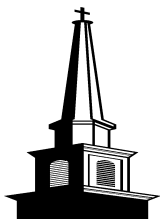
