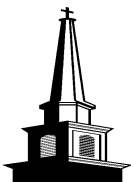
WHAT YOU WEAR ON SEPTEMBER 7th MATTERS

Did you know that the colors in the stained-glass window represent the colors of the liturgical year?

The colors of the liturgical year are BLUE for Advent, WHITE for Christmastime and Eastertime (represented by YELLOW in the windows), GREEN for “ordinary time,” PURPLE for Lent, and RED for Pentecost.

An anonymous donor will contribute money towards the 75th Anniversary Celebration funds for every member that wears at least one of the colors in the stained-glass windows. The donation will be doubled for any children that wear at least two of the colors.
