***NEW* - Water Wednesdays at Mt. Lebo Pool**

Meet up with your church friends for a mid-week break at the Mt. Lebanon Outdoor pool. Amy will be at the pool from 2:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. This is intended to create connection and provide an opportunity for **middle-school** and **high school** kids to hang out over the summer. Many of these days align with VBS Youth Leader Training, so we will meet at the church from 12:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m. for training/decorating and then head to the pool afterwards. Younger kids are welcome, but per the regular pool rules, children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult. Kids must bring money for entry (\$12) and snacks if desired. Remaining meet-up dates will be: July 16, July 30 (VBS week), August 6, & August 13.

Don't Miss Out on the Best week of Summer! Click the link in the Friday E-Blast to register. Bower Hill follows a unique youth-leader model VBS. Pre-school (potty trained) through 3rd grade attend from 9:30 a.m. - noon each day. Older youth from 4th grade and up serve as helpers in the morning, then stay through 3pm for special activities just for them. All youth aged 17 and younger must register. Cost is \$30 per child. Older kids who are volunteering only (and do not plan to stay for the afternoons) only pay for the cost of the t-shirt, which is \$15.

SUMMER SUNDAYS AT BOWER HILL:

With Pentecost behind us, Bower Hill Church goes into full summer mode! In hopes of fostering a greater sense of togetherness during scanty summer attendance, the back 7 pews on each side of the Sanctuary have been roped off. If your habitual seat is in one of those pews (as it...probably is), please consider sitting in one of the 17 rows closer to the front of the church. The preacher will be using a lectern in the center aisle, but you can still keep a good, long distance between yourself and him by sitting in the 13th or 14th row. Dress light; we cool the room with open windows and fans. Weather permitting, coffee hour will be outside and coffeeless. No adult class. The choir gets a break. The kids go straight to their classes at 9:30, no children's sermon. If a child prefers to sit in worship with their parents, they are very welcome. Also, we're gonna skip the organ and use the piano till September.

LET'S SING YOUR FAVORITE HYMN!

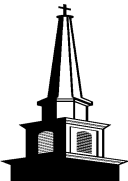
